

ROLE PROFILE

BUOY YARD TEAM MEMBER

JOB PURPOSE

A proactive member of the Buoy yard carrying out the day-to-day maintenance, repair and upgrades, in a safe and efficient manner, to the returned Buoys from sea. Occasionally the role will require visits on land or at sea to remote locations to undertake work required to Buoy, Beacons and Lighthouses.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES	Buoy operations	 Maintain a safe working environment as a priority and role model safe working practices at all times in accordance with Trinity House safety policies and relevant legislation. Collaborate with the Buoy Yard Supervisor in providing a high priority response to Aids to Navigation failures. Carry out the following activities to repair and maintain Buoys returned from sea; water jetting, grit blasting, paint spraying, assembly and load testing, to Trinity House standards. Complete all required reports in a timely manner, keeping accurate records of work as required. Assist with identifying improvements in maintenance regimes and continuous improvement projects. Advise on health and safety improvements and working standards within area of responsibility. Crane driving as required by operational need. Undertake basic electrical installations on solar panel systems. Additional activities required for Buoy Operations include; general labouring, slinger banksman, forklift and
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	Operational Functions	 Carry out routine inspections and servicing of the plant, in accordance with published procedures, and assist in higher-level plant maintenance as necessary. General labouring at lighthouses, beacons and other remote locations. Provide caretaking duties such as re-fuelling, washing of glazing, checking batteries, general maintenance of gutters, minor building maintenance, grounds maintenance to lighthouses and the cottage estate to conserve the site and keep it clear and functional. Supporting helicopter activities and act as ground crew to include Helicopter External Sling Load Operations (HESLO). Collaborate with stakeholders within stores and the vessel service as required to support operational needs. Undertake out station duties, driving to lighthouses around the Trinity House estate as requested. Ability to work away from home for periods of time across the Lighthouse estate as part of a remote team. Undertake additional tasks and responsibilities as assigned or necessary, within the scope of the role.
