#### JOB PURPOSE

A proactive member of the Buoy yard carrying day-to-day refurbishment and maintenance tasks, in a safe and efficient manner, to the returned Buoys from sea.

<b>KEY RESPONSIBILITIES</b>	<b>Buoy operations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Maintain a safe working environment as a priority and role model safe working practices at all times in accordance with Trinity House safety policies and relevant legislation.</li><li>▪ Collaborate with the Buoy Yard Supervisor in providing a high priority response to Aids to Navigation failures.</li><li>▪ Carry out the following activities to repair and maintain Buoys returned from sea; water jetting, grit blasting, some assembly and load testing, to Trinity House standards.</li><li>▪ Complete all required reports in a timely manner, keeping accurate records of work as required.</li><li>▪ Assist with identifying improvements in maintenance regimes and continuous improvement projects.</li><li>▪ Advise on health and safety improvements and working standards within area of responsibility.</li><li>▪ Additional activities required for Buoy Operations include; general labouring and record keeping.</li></ul>
